Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility. All ISC classes will have 4.3' jump bars except for the back bar in the spread hurdle which will be a 5' displaceable jump bar. Any ISC classes that have a broad jump will be using the ascending (FCI) style Broad Jump and any ISC classes that have a tire will be using the FCI heights for the tire.

NOTES FROM TRIAL SECRETARY

1. Please remember to check the No Signature Required box AND sign that spot where you authorize them to deliver any overnight package. Our Post Office knows that we do not accept signature-required packages and they will not even attempt to deliver them. They just mark them "Refused" and return them to the sender. We never even know that you sent that package to us.
2. With all the paperwork we handle, mistakes are inevitable. We send out both Preliminary Confirmations and Final Confirmations. PLEASE read these and double check that all the information is correct. Having to change Gate boards, scribe sheets and computer records the day of the trial or the week of the trial is very difficult.
3. Emails received on Friday, Saturday or Sunday will be responded to by Monday afternoon. Please remember that we are not in the office these days as we are on site scoring trials. Do not send multiple emails with the same request during these days. If you don't hear back from us by mid day Monday please reach out as we may not have received your request. We always send a reply email with a revised confirmation attached to all emailed move-up or cancelation requests once they are processed.

Data Entry and Changes to your Information

Data entry mistakes happen. That is why Fast Times asks everyone to READ both preliminary & final confirmations. For the majority of entries, dog and owner/handler information remains the same. We ask that you **highlight any** of the following changes on your entry forms:

New email address
 New Titles
 New Handler
 New address and/or phone number
 New jump height
 (including jump height changes from trial to trial. For example, dog jumps 20" at one trial, then 24C" in the next trial.)

Highlighting these changes on entry forms is very helpful so that these changes can be updated in the Fast Times database. ALWAYS review your confirmations carefully to ensure that your requested changes have been made.

ISC eligibility, jump heights, & level description:

Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (<http://www.akc.org>).

Eligibility: ISC classes are open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. There is no Preferred Option for ISC; dogs may enter at their preferred jump height, however they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping the same jump height.

Jump Heights: Dogs may be entered in their regular jump heights, however, only those dogs running in the 12", 16", 20" and 24" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) may use their clean run toward the required qualification toward entering WTT or EOTT. Please see the EO/AWC Tryout Rules for further details.

The FCI/ISC cutoffs for those heights are as follows:

- Small (12" jump height) – for dogs measuring less than 13 ¾"
- Medium (16" jump height) – for dogs measuring less than 16 7/8"
- Intermediate (20" jump height) – for dogs measuring less than 18 7/8"
- Large (24" jump height) – for dogs measuring 18 7/8" or more

This is not a Regional World Team Qualifying event. There will NOT be an automatic invite of the combined winners to WTT.

A1 (Agility 1) and J1 (Jumping 1) are the beginning levels of FCI/ISC Courses.
 A2 (Agility 2) and J2 (Jumping 2) are the intermediate levels of FCI/ISC Courses.
 A3 (Agility 3) and J3 (Jumping 3) are the master levels of FCI/ISC Courses.
 A clean run at any level ISC counts towards EO tryouts requirements. A clean run in A2, J2, A3 or J3 level ISC counts towards WT tryout requirements.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO) FEO runs WILL be allowed at these trials.

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring.
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Wait List for Withdrawn Entries after Closing

All entries must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial closing date. This trial is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing. A maximum of 50 dogs will be placed on the wait list for this event.

- Any entry withdraw requests received by 8 am the **Wednesday**, ONE WEEK BEFORE the trial weekend will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available.
- If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a waitlisted entry, a refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry minus a \$5 processing fee.
- Waitlisted entries that do not move off the wait list into the trial by **Wednesday @ 8 am** ONE WEEK BEFORE the trial weekend will receive a refund.

If there is not a waitlist, there is no refund if you want to pull after the closing date.

If you have not heard about your Wait List status by Friday the week before the trial weekend, please contact Fast Times ASAP.

Premier Sports site rules:

Any participant who is not feeling well, please stay home!

Crating: Climate controlled Indoor Crating is allowed in designated areas. You must bring a tarp to place under your crate.

Parking: Please Park where Premier Staff directs you. Absolutely no double parking will be permitted. If you do not park within the lines, you will be asked to move. Do not park in any business neighbor's lot unless directed by Premier Staff. Vehicles not in compliance with parking rules will be towed at the owner's expense. There is limited handicapped parking, please arrive early to obtain a spot. If you need help finding a parking space, you may temporarily park in front of the building and ask for Premier Staff to help you park.

Dog Exercise Areas: Premier Sports Center has 4 acres of grass for you and your dogs to enjoy. All dogs need to be on leash and under control at all times while on Premier Sports Center premises, both indoors and outside. The only exceptions for off leash is when at the practice jump or in the ring. Poop bags are to be discarded in outside trash receptacles only. Do not walk your dog on our business neighbor's properties. Pay attention to your dog and pick up after your dog. Anyone seen in person or on video not picking up after their dog or walking on the neighbor's property will be subject to a bench hearing and immediate excusal from the Center for the remaining day(s) of the trial. Do not let your male dog lift its leg on the building, front landscaping, or on any item a human needs to handle.

Please be considerate of the public restrooms. Trashcans will be placed in the bathrooms for proper disposal of paper products other than toilet paper. No dogs allowed in public restrooms. Personal chairs/handicap chairs will not be allowed on the turf field. We will provide bench seating in the front of the rings for all to use. Please remove your personal belongings when your class has ended.

Smoking: Is not permitted inside our facility and not encouraged outside near others. We prefer if you must smoke that it is done inside your vehicle and that your butts are discarded in your vehicle ashtray.

Sports Center Hours: Each day, the facility will open one hour before the first run and close approximately one hour after the last run at which time the doors will be locked. Be prepared.

Hotels: The Hotel Info that we have provided on our website/premium are an extension of the trial site. Reports of barking dogs left unattended in the hotel or other behavior deemed inappropriate by the hotel management may be subject to a bench hearing. You must clean up after your dogs at the hotel. You are responsible for any damage your dog does to hotel property.

Good Sportsmanship: Please treat others with kindness and respect.

Absolutely no aggressive behavior will be tolerated by a person or dog towards another. Any person or dog who is seen acting in an aggressive manner will be asked to leave and no refund will be given and may be subject to a bench hearing. If you have an issue with a person or dog please see the Club Trial Chairman immediately. If you have an issue with the building, property, equipment, parking lot, please see a Premier Member.

Dumpster Abuse @ Premier: Recently we are noticing more items being thrown into our dumpster. Paint materials, large plastic bins, broken dog crates etc. To empty the dumpster, we are charged by the weight and trip, and it is very expensive. ******TRIAL REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITORS*****

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A \$30 fee will be charged for most bounced checks. Additional fees will apply for checks returned due to exhibitor negligence (ie: stop payment, insufficient funds, closed account).

TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules attached to the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.

ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as trial closes or limits are reached. Acknowledgment of entries will include confirmation notices.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the match, no refund of entry fees will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

WALK-THRUS. No umbrellas allowed during walk-thrus.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

TRIAL COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

DOGS This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), AKC Canine Partners listing number (if the trial-giving club is offering the option of Canine Partners entries. See front page of the premium for that information), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. All American dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate if the trial-giving club is offering the option of mixed breed entries and provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to judging, otherwise, they must be available for measuring before their class begins.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

This club agrees to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

The MASCMA Challenge Cup:

MASCMA is the Miniature American Shepherd Club of the Mid Atlantic, which is a regional affiliate club of MASCUSA, the Miniature American Shepherd Club of the USA, the parent club of the breed.

MASCMA's territory is New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Maryland, Delaware, West Virginia, Virginia and the District of Columbia. MASCMA is sponsoring the trophies for this event.

In addition to the flat ribbons awarded for 1st through 4th placements in each jump height each day, rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 3rd placements for Level 3 combined high score in each jump height each day, for Level 2 combined high score in each jump height each day and also for Level 1 combined high score in each jump height each day.

The MASCMA Challenge Cup Level 3 trophy will be awarded to the overall winner for Level 3 combined each day. The MASCMA Challenge Cup Level 2 trophy will be awarded to the overall winner for Level 2 combined each day and the MASCMA Challenge Cup Level 1 trophy will be awarded to the overall winner for Level 1 combined each day.

And, although this is an all-breed agility trial, because we had so many Miniature American Shepherds entered last year, we are also awarding trophies each day for the highest scoring Miniature American Shepherd in Level 3 combined, in Level 2 combined and in Level 1 combined.

To be eligible for the Level 3 combined rosettes and trophy, teams must be entered in both level 3 classes offered that day. To be eligible for the Level 2 combined rosettes and trophy, teams must be entered in both level 2 classes offered that day. To be eligible for the Level 1 combined rosettes and trophy, teams must be entered in both level 1 classes offered that day.

On Saturday, the combined prizes will be offered in the order: Level 1, Level 2 and then Level 3. The winner of the Level 1 combined prize will not be eligible for the Level 2 or 3 combined prize and the winner of the Level 2 combined prize will not be eligible for the Level 3 combined prize.

On Sunday, the combined prizes will be offered in this order: Level 2, Level 3, and then Level 1. The winner of the Level 2 combined prize will not be eligible for the Level 3 or Level 1 combined prize and the winner of the Level 3 combined prize will not be eligible for the Level 1 combined prize.

Scoring for the MASCMA Challenge Cup is as follows:

R = 3 points

S = 5 points

Time Faults = 2 points for each second over time

E = 75 points

Fix and Go is scored as an E

FEO is scored as absent

Scores are cumulative and are time plus faults.

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or **back-to-back trials only**. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM** be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
